While you are familiar with the Women's Refuge in Vero Beach, most of you don't know me. Though the regular program is for a period of at least three months, I am a graduate of the two-week "Come and See" program. During those two short weeks, the Lord dramatically changed my life.

Because of the changes the Lord made in my life, I want to help the Women's Refuge change the lives of other women. This is the sole purpose of my letter.

To enable the Women's Refuge to provide other women with an opportunity for a truly life changing & healing experience with the Lord, they have the following needs:

- ❖ **Additional Housing** – They have a waiting list that continues to grow. The Transition House, which is only half-way finished due to a need for additional funds, will provide the additional housing needed.
- ❖ **Operational Expense** – While they are very careful with the funds that the Lord provides, and each woman in the program is required to assist in the day to day duties and maintenance of the facility, operational costs continue to grow.

I challenge the body of Christ to help meet these needs. He has certainly challenged me in this area.

So, for every \$1,000 or more contribution to the Refuge, I will send to you, *or* someone you wish to honor, this very special statue titled "Born Again". This image represents what the Lord has done in my life as well as the lives of hundreds of other women who have come through the program.
