At a time in my life when everything seemed to be going as planned, I found myself angry, broken, and filled with fear and hurt. I had a wonderful family, a successful career, a beautiful home, and wanted for nothing. We attended church at Calvary Chapel Vero Beach, traveled to destinations I never imaged, and life was good.

After many sleepless nights and prayers my son returned safely from Afghanistan. Then my world felt like it came tumbling down after an arguement with my son, which broke the relationship between us for several years. At this point, my best friend said to me, "You need to seek godly counseling... I have never heard you like this... This is not you." I felt completely out of control and filled with fear and emotions I've never had before.

At the suggestion of a friend, God sent me to the Women's Refuge for godly counseling. He met me there and changed my life. In sessions with my counselor, Donna, the founder of the Women's Refuge, she helped me to realize the hurt and pain I felt was rooted in my past. She understood the effects of alcoholism on a family and asked hard questions that led me to seek God for answers.

God revealed that my missing piece was a relationship with Him. As the daughter of an alcoholic and a young single mother who suffered abuse, I had bottled up my struggles for many years. Though I gave my life to Jesus at nine, I hadn't been walking in relationship with Him, nor trusting God.

Each meeting with Donna brought new revelations about my need for healing and a reliance on God. I had come to the end of myself, and I was just where God wanted me to be. Now, I am a new person who trusts God, lives with purpose, and allows God to

continue to prune my branches. I learned to lean in and let go of things I can't control.

I am forever grateful for the Women's Refuge and their amazing counselors and volunteers who help broken women find peace. I pray that if you are struggling to find peace, you would reach out to the Refuge. Humble yourself and allow God to work in you and through you.
