salm 1:2-3 says, "...but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on his law day and night. That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither—whatever they do prospers."

I was 28 years old, serving as the Assistant Pastor in a medium-sized church. Our oldest son was in preschool, and so when I wasn't working, my attention and focus went to our son, family, and running the household. I was setting very little time, if any, aside for daily devotions. It seemed that we had barely adjusted to the idea of having our second baby when tragedy struck our young family experienced. I was more than halfway through the pregnancy when we learned that our unborn baby boy had died. Due to the term of the pregnancy, I had to go through labor and delivery with our little one. I was grieving, physically exhausted, and my spiritual tank was empty. All those months of working and raising our family but not being in God's Word, caught up to me in our crisis. I was able to take some much-needed time off to rest and heal at my parents' home while they helped take care of our oldest son.

Early one morning during my quiet time, I read Psalm 1, and tears began to stream down my face. I wrote the entire Psalm out by hand in the front of my Bible. In those moments, I knew that I never wanted to be that spiritually dry again.

Right then and there, I prayed and vowed before God that I would never neglect to be in His word daily again. Since then, I have had other painful and challenging seasons in my life, going through the heartache of divorce, the tragic loss of my 17-year-old nephew in an automobile accident, but through the years, I learned to rest on the assurance and the truth of that Psalm. I learned a valuable lesson about life and faith during one of the saddest seasons of my young adult life.

You see, when we practice the habit of meditating on God's word daily and applying it to our lives, no matter what life brings our way, we no longer have to wither, but instead, we can be like roots planted in the streams of HIS living water.

I thank God for the healing ministry of Jesus Christ that the Women's Refuge offers to women and families when they are hurting, in crisis, grieving, or searching for healing. The Women's Refuge provides a safe place for retreat and restoration for those in a difficult season of their lives. This ministry would not be possible without your faithful support

My time here has been filled with blessings. It has not been easy, yet necessary


