t had been nearly two months since Elizabeth's arrest. Sitting in confinement, recounting the events that led to the incident, she wondered where God was. She hoped to escape her painful memories of abuse, but instead, they came flooding in like a tsunami. "Make it go away, God. Please make it all stop," she thought.

The ripple effect of bad choices finally caught up to her. For years, Elizabeth tried to cope with her pain. It was common to blame her anger and explosive patterns on her circumstances or those around her, including those closest to her.

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." Jeremiah 29:11

To be free meant more than removing the shackles of abuse, anger, and unforgiveness. It meant that Elizabeth would have to surrender to God to experience true freedom. Would she give up her ways and let God heal her pain?

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." 2 Corinthians 5:17 "Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:32

At the Refuge, we see women who do not know how to deal with abuse and unforgiveness. For them, bitterness and pain can turn into more suffering. Like Elizabeth, the consequences of not dealing with the core issues of child-hood trauma can lead to destructive behaviors. Women who come to our program often blame others, justifying their actions. It is a coping mechanism to mask their pain.

But the Women's Refuge is here to help provide healing from painful life experiences. We teach and equip women to break free from the chains of abuse.
