

# Becoming God's Masterpiece

Almost 10 years ago to the day, I found myself at the end of my rope. I had no hope. My life was empty and void of meaning. I had plenty of reasons to see myself as a victim. I was sexually abused as a child, was in an abusive marriage, and had no relationship with my three children. I had also been in psychiatric hospitals, had ECT treatments, and battled with self-mutilation and suicidal thoughts. I believed the Refuge was my last hope. In one sense that was true, but I learned I was placing my hope in the wrong things.

Jeremiah 17:7 says, "*Blessed are those who trust in the Lord and have made the Lord their hope and confidence.*" The Refuge guided me to a hope and healing that came by trusting God and looking to Him for my strength and meaning in life.

In March 2024, I returned to the Women's Refuge for the internship program. God continued to teach me and I developed a more intimate relationship with Him. I knew there was a God, but I had no idea who He really was or how much He loved me. If He loved me, why would He allow all these things to happen to me? At the Women's Refuge I learned that everything we go through has a purpose and I experienced the unconditional love of Jesus Christ.

Through a support group called **Shelter from the Storm**, I realized I did not have to be a victim. I could be

a survivor. Our past does not define who we are. It is not our identity. Our identity is in Jesus Christ who loves us with an everlasting love. We are not victims. When we trust Jesus and look to Him for our identity, we not only will be survivors, but we will also be thrivers.
