

Twenty-five years ago, almost to the day, the doors of the Women's Refuge opened, welcoming women suffering from life's difficulties to receive help with counsel, care, and restoration from God's Word. They came with depression, anxiety, trauma, family dysfunction, suicidal tendencies, and more. In turn, we offered hope, help, and healing for those suffering from emotional, mental, and spiritual distress.

Over time, involving family members in their care became evident, thus birthing our community counseling center. Today, our biblical counselors meet with men, women, and young adults in our counseling office where we address individual, family, and marital mental health issues with biblical truths.

After several months with the Women's Refuge, *Kathy's life was renewed and restored, reuniting with her family, no longer suffering from depression.

*Kathy's life could have ended drastically if others hadn't responded to the call to minister to broken and shattered lives. Mental health has never been in more of a crisis than now: 90% of us have been impacted by a mental health crisis with a family member, friend, coworker, or even ourselves. Despair permeates our daily lives, crippling many of us. The Women's Refuge is here to give hope that a change can be made for a victorious life through Christ.
